TO QUALIFY

TEAMS OR SQUADS- Any school sponsoring an interscholastic team will be permitted to enter Districts, provided the provisions of Rule 2, Section 18 of the NJSIAA Constitution and Bylaws are met.

INDIVIDUALS - Individuals from schools which do not compete on an interscholastic basis are eligible to enter provided they can document their fencing experience. All individual fencers must report to Hackettstown, on Saturday, February 5, 2005, for preliminary competition. See separate sheet (*Qualifying Process for Independent Fencers*) for more information.

ATTENTION ATHLETIC DIRECTOR/COACHES

Schools not presently competing on an interscholastic basis, but entering individuals, are advised to read carefully the Procedures - "Coaches" Appointed to Accompany Teams or Individuals to NJSIAA Championships in the NJSIAA Handbook. Tournament Directors will disqualify any contestant who is accompanied by someone in a coaching/spotting capacity who is not properly certified and appointed by the Board of Education. A properly appointed coach will thereafter be subject to the Rules and Regulations, Rule 2, Section 11 - Out-of-Season Practice. If a substitute coach is used, written authority from the school's Principal must be presented.

RULE 6. FENCING

Section 1. Rules The United States Fencing Association Rules shall Govern all NJSIAA meets.

Section 2. Start of Practice. – Friday after Thanksgiving.

Section 3. Start of Regular Season. Friday before the third Saturday of December.

Section 4. End of Season (From Rule 2, Section 10)

All teams may participate in interscholastic contests up to the final championship in their respective sports. Individual competition shall terminate with the end of said competition.

POSTPONEMENT

Responsibility for postponing a match will be the responsibility of the Athletic Directors of the two competing teams, and it shall be the home team's Athletic Director's responsibility to notify the Tournament Director prior to game time if a postponement is necessary. The Tournament Director will be responsible for postponement of finals and consolations.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR DISTRICT AND STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

RULES The United States Fencing Association (USFA) rules with NJSIAA modifications will govern all tournament play.

DISQUALIFICATION: Participation by an ineligible participant in any meet during the regular season results in forfeiture of those points achieved by the individual participant. If an ineligible participant participates in the tournament, said participant will be disqualified from the tournament immediately and the next finisher will advance in his place; schools eliminated prior to the last opponent will not re-enter tournament competition.

SCORING: The final standings of the regular competition will be computed on a basis of totaling the won-loss bouts for the day. This will consist of a complete round robin of fencers of all schools that have entered.

Fencers shall be designated as A, B, C.

Team events will be fenced as a team (C vs. C, B vs. B, A vs. A) beginning with the lowest fencers.

TIE-BREAKER In case of ties, the following tie-breaker procedure will be followed:

Individual Competition

- a. Ties for first place will be resolved by a "fence-off";
- b. Other ties will be broken on the basis of indicators following USFA Regulations.

Team Competition

Ties will be broken on the basis of indicators following USFA Regulations. Subsection: 1. Total touches scored, minus total touches received;
 2. Most touches scored.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. A school which arrives after the fencing competition has started will be disqualified from the competition immediately.
2. Changes in line-up after entry blanks have been received will be permitted, but this change must be reported immediately to the Bout Committee Chairperson.
3. No person who is directly or indirectly associated with a school should act as an official in the same bout in which a participant from the school is competing.
4. Team must bring the following:
 - a. Complete and untorn uniform covering the legs and knees for each fencer.
 - b. The manager of each team should be present and should bring a timing clock in good working order. If a team has no regular manager, then a substitute fencer should bring a clock and be ready to act as a timer.
 - c. **ALL BOUTS WILL BE FENCED WITH ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT. EACH BOYS TEAM AND EACH GIRLS TEAM MUST BRING WITH THEM COMPLETE ELECTRICAL SCORING APPARATUS IN GOOD WORKING ORDER. IT WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TEAM COACH TO OBTAIN OR BORROW SAID EQUIPMENT. ALL EQUIPMENT MUST BE CLEARLY LABELED WITH SCHOOL NAME. ANY SCHOOL FAILING TO PROVIDE FUNCTIONING ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT MAY BE DISQUALIFIED AT THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR'S DISCRETION, IF THE**

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (continued)**CIRCUMSTANCES PRESENT A DELAY IN CONDUCTING THE MEET IN A SMOOTH AND EFFICIENT MANNER AT THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR'S DISCRETION.**

- d. **Each boys and girls teams must provide foil weights and epee weights and shims** for the district tournament. These will be used for every bout.
 - e. Each fencer must have at least two (2) electrical weapons and body cords in working order with him/her at each bout.
 - f. All teams and individuals entering the tournament must be accompanied by their coaches or certified faculty members from their schools who will be directly responsible for the teams. **Coaches must be present for the entire competition.**
5. Fencers should only fence their own pools (e.g. "A" strip, "B" strip, or "C" strip) No credit will be given for bouts fenced on the wrong strip. Fencing on the wrong strip will result in a 0-0 defeat for the offending fencer.
 6. Any number of substitutes may be used. Substitutions will be permitted at all levels. Substitutions must be reported directly on the strip. The substitute shall remain in the reported position until such change has been made. Substitutions and fencers may not change levels once they have competed in a given position, but may re-enter.
 7. **WITHDRAWAL:** Any school or contestant who fails to appear for the **State Championships** after having qualified in the District Championships will be subject to any penalties as enforced by the NJSIAA and barred from participation in the Fencing Championships, at all levels. (i.e. the District and State Championships, the following year unless extraordinary circumstances caused such unforeseen withdrawal.) A fencer and/or his team who opts to participate in National, Regional or non-NJSIAA competition in conflict with the NJSIAA championships, including postponements, is subject to this penalty.

IF YOU CANNOT COMPLY - DON'T ENTER**TIMING OF BOUTS**

1. Each bout will be USFA regulation time.
2. When time expires with a tie score, the tie will be broken according to the priority rule of USFA.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

1. Upon arrival, report to registration desk for assignment to dressing rooms.
2. Team competitors must be dressed in clean fencing attire and report to their first round strip at the starting time for Districts and State Championships.
3. Refreshments may be available for purchase.

NOTE: A trainer will be in attendance and an ambulance on call for the Championships.

ATHLETIC EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

Each school participating in the tournament will provide for the care and treatment of their athletes within the school's policy as in effect during the regular season. The athletic emergency procedure of the host school will be in effect during the tournament which should include the establishment of a line of communication for emergent situations.

ATTENTION: Principals, Athletic Directors, All Coaches and Referees

RE: Recommended Precautions Against The Transmission of Blood-Borne Pathogens

All member schools must provide all coaches with the contents of the **NJSIAA Infectious Disease Policy**.

The Infectious Disease Policy provides that:

If an individual gets someone else's blood on his skin, protective gloves should be worn to wipe the blood off with a disposable towel using soap and water.

Note: If any blood gets on an opponent's uniform during competition or a teammate's uniform during practice, it is not necessary to clean the uniform at that point unless the opponent or teammate has an open cut or unskinned area, or the blood is on a part of the uniform which might come in contact with mucous membranes. If the student-athlete does have an open cut or unskinned area or believes the blood might come in contact with mucous membranes, then the uniform should be wiped with soap and water.

PROTESTS

Protests based upon an official's judgment, or misinterpretation, or misapplication of the playing rules will not be honored as per *NJSIAA Bylaws*, Article VII, Section 1.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES/ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES

Players and coaches involved with alcoholic beverages and/or illegal substances before, during or after the game, at the game site or on school property, including chartered busses, shall be suspended from NJSIAA tournament play for one year and be denied any championship rights.

This action was taken in support of the fact that such actions concerning alcoholic beverages and illegal substances are in violation of New Jersey State statutes and will be strictly enforced.

SALES/SOLICITATIONS

Only NJSIAA promotional items will be sold at NJSIAA sponsored events. For the 2004/05 seasons, First Division is the designated vendor.

Solicitations, sale of publications or products, or similar activities *ARE NOT PERMITTED* without prior authorization from the NJSIAA.

The New Jersey State Interscholastic Athletic Association is the sponsoring association for all levels of State Tournament/Championships. The NJSIAA reserves all rights in regard to the management of these Tournaments/Championships and the sale or distribution of clothing, souvenirs or any other items is strictly prohibited without permission from the NJSIAA.

AWARDS - DISTRICT AND STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Squad Awards - A squad trophy and three (3) gold medals to the District and State squad champions; three (3) silver medals to the second place squad finisher and three (3) bronze medals to the third place squad finishers.

Team Awards - A team trophy for the overall team champion in the State Championship (1) and for each District Team Champion (4), and nine (9) gold medals for the State Championship team and each of the District Team Champions (27).

Individual Awards - A gold medal to the district and State Champion; a silver medal to the second place finisher and a bronze medal to the third place finisher in each weapon (Foil, Sabre, Epee).

THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE NJSIAA HAS RULED THAT MEMBER SCHOOLS FAILING TO FORWARD TOURNAMENT FORMS TO **THE PROPER ADDRESS** WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM TOURNAMENT COMPETITION IN THAT SPORT.

Note: SCHOOLS NOT WILLING OR ABLE TO COMPLY WITH TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS SHOULD NOT ENTER THE TOURNAMENT.

BROADCASTING REGULATIONS

Television/Cable/Internet

The NJSIAA Executive Committee has approved the following schedule for television/cable/internet broadcasting of NJSIAA tournament events. Please be advised that the local site manager may not permit the televising of a event without prior written authorization from the NJSIAA Central Office.

Commercial Broadcasting

Commercial broadcasting operators are advised to consider the following prior to submitting a request to NJSIAA:

- A. Local site availability, constraints, policies, security, negotiated agreements, etc.
- B. Broadcaster, as part of their agreement with NJSIAA, must provide a minimum of six (6) complimentary announcements on behalf of the NJSIAA, two (2) of which may be on behalf of the prime sponsor of the activity. NJSIAA shall make the determination regarding this matter.
- C. Broadcaster must submit their request to produce a particular tournament event to the NJSIAA Central Office at least two (2) days prior to the date of the event.
- D. Announcers employed by a broadcaster are to be advised of the NJSIAA's objectives of "sportsmanship" and "fairplay" relating to their descriptions of individual occurrences and officials decisions.
- E. Broadcaster shall produce final awards ceremony at championship events.
- F. Broadcaster shall provide NJSIAA with five (5) videos of each event produced. These videos should be sent by the broadcaster to NJSIAA within one (1) month of the date of the event.
- G. Broadcasters will indemnify and save NJSIAA harmless from any claims instituted by third parties.
- H. **Broadcasting fees vary, depending on the event. For fee structure contact the NJSIAA office (609-259-2776 or fax 609.259.3047).**

Highlight Broadcast

(Television/Cable)

- A. Highlight broadcasts of contests are restricted to two (2) minutes of broadcasting time. Action shots of the event are restricted to one (1) minute of broadcast time.
 - 1. Video copy of actual broadcast must be sent to the NJSIAA Central Office within seven (7) days after the event. Future approval requests shall be related to this regulation.
- B. Highlight broadcast requests must be made to the NJSIAA Central Office at least two (2) days prior to the event. Approved Highlight television broadcast rights agreements shall be FAX returned to the applicant and to the local Site Director.
- C. The local Site Manager may not permit the Highlight televising of a event without prior FAX authorization from the NJSIAA Central Office.
- D. Highlight crews are limited to a maximum of (2) persons (one [1] hand-held camera).
- E. Highlight camera crew shall be limited to assigned ground space available assigned by the Site Director or NJSIAA staff.
- F. Post game interviews shall take place after the "sportsmanship" handshake and award ceremonies.
- G. Highlight broadcasters will indemnify and save NJSIAA harmless from any claims instituted by third parties.

School Television Broadcasting

Member schools may televise NJSIAA tournament events, without any charge from the NJSIAA, provided the schools observe the following requirements:

- A. Broadcast will not take place for a forty-eight (48) hour delayed period.
- B. Broadcast shall only be to community or communities of the school district.
- C. There shall not be any sponsors or paid advertisements mentioned or shown during the broadcast.
- D. Only teachers, students and volunteer adults, approved by the district Board of Education, will be involved in the production and broadcast of the event.
- E. Schools requesting broadcasting rights must submit their request to produce a particular tournament event to the NJSIAA Central Office at least two (2) days prior to the date of the event. Specific facility constraints, policies, security, negotiated documents etc. should be reviewed prior to making an application.
- F. District Board of Education will indemnify and save NJSIAA harmless from claims instituted by third parties.

Radio Stations

Radio broadcasting operators are advised to consider the following prior to submitting a request to NJSIAA:

- A. Local site availability, constraints, policies, security, negotiated agreements, etc.
- B. Broadcaster, as part of their agreement with NJSIAA, must provide a minimum of six (6) complimentary announcements on behalf of the NJSIAA, two (2) of which may be on behalf of the prime sponsor of the activity. NJSIAA shall make the determination regarding this matter.
 - Broadcaster must submit their request to produce a particular tournament event to the NJSIAA Central Office at least two (2) days prior to the date of the event.
- D. Announcers employed by a broadcaster are to be advised of the NJSIAA's objectives of "sportsmanship" and "fair play" relating to their descriptions of individual occurrences and officials decisions.
- E. Post game interviews shall take place after the "sportsmanship" handshake and award ceremonies.
- F. Radio broadcast requests must be made to the NJSIAA Central Office at least two (2) days prior to the event. Approved radio broadcast rights agreements shall be FAX returned to the applicant and to the local Site Director.
- G. The local Site Manager may not permit the radio broadcasting of a event without prior FAX authorization from the NJSIAA Central Office.
- H. Broadcasters will indemnify and save NJSIAA harmless from any claims instituted by third parties.
